Lockdown: Rufus Ebegba Centre Alleviates 300 Widows, Aged in Delta

The Rufus Ebegba Centre for Leadership & Environmental Sustainability (Rufus Ebegba Centre) has extended its hands of charity to widows and aged persons in parts of Isoko land and Ughelli in Delta State.

According to a statement released by the Centre in Abuja, the move to alleviate the living conditions of the people in the Ughelli and Isoko areas became necessary in the wake of the lockdown imposed on socioeconomic and official activities in Delta State in order to contain the spread of the Covid-19 pandemic.

The Centre noted that as part of its mandate to provide leadership models for optimal management of human and environmental resources, it had to respond to the reports of extreme suffering and lack that were being experienced by many people, especially the aged and widows whose means of income, often from petty trading and farming have been seriously hampered by the lockdown. "The goodwill hitherto enjoyed by these economically vulnerable persons from their usual benefactors have ceased owing to the lockdown. It was therefore important that in order to sustain the lockdown out of a public health necessity, it is also necessary to sustain the well being of the weak in the society" in the state have been depleted. The Rufus Ebegba Centre extends its operations across the entire Federation of Nigeria and is currently working assiduously to raise funds to also alleviate the conditions of other widows and aged persons in other states in Nigeria ", the statement read.

Pictures and videos of the presentation of the palliatives to the recipients by representatives of the Centre, were laden with emotions of gratitude expressed by the the widows and aged. Some of the women were seen praying for the Centre and its founder, Dr Rufus Ebegba, the Director General of the Nigerian Biosafety and Management Agency (NBMA)
